Your financial support allows us to continue to pay the bills including parish salaries, program costs (like the Gospel Weeklies Family Faith Formation Program, Sunday Masses that are offered online, and community outreach) and ongoing operating costs (like insurance, water, electricity, etc.), all of which would not be possible without your ongoing generosity.

We are sensitive to the hardships that the measures being taken to prevent the spread of COVID-19 may be having on some people. With that in mind, and mindful of your own circumstances, we are sharing the following options for supporting St Mark's:

- For those who prefer not to use online banking, donations can be mailed to the Parish at: St Mark's Parish, 171 Pettingill Rd., Quispamsis, NB, E2E 2V6. Consistent with Canada Post guidelines, please do not mail cash – cheques are recommended.
- E-transfer your donation.
- Contribute through pre-authorized giving (the PAD program). The application form is available on St Mark's web site or please contact Dianne at (506) 849-5111 to have it e-mailed or sent to you in the mail.
- Contribute through the "Donate" button on St Mark's website.
- Call the parish office to make a donation via credit card.

All donations, regardless of the method you choose to use, are recorded for Income Tax receipts that are issued at the end of the year.
