

From the Handbook of the Mass

"This is My body"

Jesus said these words over the bread on the night of the institution of the Eucharist. When in his turn the priest pronounces these words in His name, they have the same power that they had when they were said for the first time. So they perform what they assert. The bread becomes the body of the risen Christ. The word "body" does not mean here only a part of Christ, but His whole being. Saint Thomas Aquinas wrote: "Under each species [of the bread and wine] the whole Christ is present." So by receiving the bread, the believer receives the whole Christ.
